This docket will be called IN PERSON in the 47<sup>th</sup> District Courtroom in **AMARILLO, POTTER COUNTY, TEXAS**. At that time, **jury** cases will be set for trial for the week of **January 6, 2026** in the order they appear below. Subject to the setting of any jury matter, all **non-jury** matters may be scheduled for trial during this trial week or at a different date and time at the convenience of the Court's schedule.

**Announcements of READY may be made by email PRIOR to docket call – All parties must be included in the email – Parties making announcements prior to docket call DO NOT need to appear in person for docket call on 12/12/25.**

Contested motions for continuances must be scheduled to be heard at or before the call of this docket to be considered. Agreed motions and written orders for continuance signed by **all attorneys and parties** may be presented and considered prior to docket call.

**Pre-trial motions will not be heard morning of jury trial.** Pre-trial motions for a bench trial may be heard morning of trial if time will allow. If a pre-trial hearing is needed the attorneys must contact the court to schedule.

**No oral continuances will be granted absent exigent circumstances.**
